Health and Safety Prequalification Assessment - Contractors Health & Safety (CHAS) Assessment Scheme

I have completed my assessment of your application for CHAS registration. You will recall you provided a reply to some health and safety questions and sent selected evidence used assessing compliance of your policy, organisation and arrangements for health and safety.

I am pleased to tell you your application is compliant and registered in the database. You should not take compliance as a right of entry to an approved or select list. Our clients have the right to ask for extra H&S information on future applications especially at invitation to tender stage.

We do not issue a certificate of "CHAS Compliance" (or a registration number) as this could, in some circumstances lead to misuse of our copyright and lost revenue to the scheme. You are welcome to tell clients you are CHAS compliant and should they need confirmation, can get this through the scheme administration team.

We can license your company to use a suitable registered CHAS logo on stationery and livery and have a "Certificate of Accreditation" if you want. You will need to register as an "accredited contractor or consultant". For more information about this and an application form, please visit the CHAS website www.chas.gov.uk and click on "What is Accreditation?". (Accreditation needs a full annual CHAS reassessment).

CHAS accreditation can attract reduced employers and public liability insurance and currently negates the need to complete the Constructionline health and safety questionnaire when registering with them. One of the main aims of our scheme is to reduce unnecessary duplication. If your company is asked to complete a CHAS or similar questionnaire by one of our clients please contact them before completing that application to verify what is wanted. (A list of clients is on our web site)
